Location

NYC is conveniently located at the gateway to Toronto's boating center, close to Toronto's downtown and entertainment district while being adjacent to cultural and recreational facilities such as the Exhibition Grounds, Harbourfront and the Martin Goodman Trail.

Arriving By Boat

The NYC is located at the western end of the Western Gap, to the north shore. The NYC Dockmaster monitors VHF channel 68 and can be contacted by hailing "**National Yacht Club**". Upon arrival, visitors must pull up to the front wall and register at the Officer of the Day station (OOD).

Reciprocal Agreement

The NYC offers "true reciprocity" to all visiting yachts. Should the reciprocal club not have provided a clear outline of the reciprocal club policy, there will be a \$20.00 charge for the first night, with the next two nights free. Each additional night thereafter shall carry a charge of \$20.00 per night. Please note there will be a 5-day limit per year. Reservations are not accepted and all visitors are welcomed on a first come basis.

Dockage

At the NYC, depending on availability, we offer docks ranging from 24 feet to 45 feet in length with water and power provided. Please use bow, stern and spring lines. Tie halyards and lines to reduce noise.

Dining Room

The dining room is fully licensed and provides a full menu, including daily specials. PLEASE NOTE: Payment for all food and beverage services are cashless. The Club accepts VISA, MasterCard and debit as forms of payment.

Dress is informal but hats must be removed. Shoes and shirts are required in the Clubhouse at all times.

Showers & Laundry

Washrooms, showers and laundry facilities are located on the ground floor of the clubhouse. These can be accessed 24 hours a day through the western doors of the clubhouse by using the keypad entrance code.



Wi-Fi

Pedestrian Gate

The showers and laundry code also opens the walk-in gate at the south-east corner of the property.

Pump Out

A self-serve pumpout facility is provided for use. There is a \$15.00 charge per use. Please see the OOD on duty for access.

Barbeques

Onboard BBQ's are NOT to be used on the docks. Club owned BBQs are available for use.

Pets

Must be kept on a leash at all times. Please pick up after your pet. **Pets are not allowed in the Clubhouse.** Off-leash dog park at Coronation Park, north of NYC Basin (10 min walk).

Garbage & Recycling

Garbage and recycling receptacles located on the east and west sides of the clubhouse. Larger bins located in the south-east corner of the property.

Local Transportation

TTC Streetcar Service - Available at Queens Quay and Bathurst Street. Cost is \$3.25 (exact change required)

Taxi Service - Numbers available from the OOD Station, Bar and Office.
